There is no school Friday, November 13<sup>th</sup>, due to a teacher work day for Elementary students. All report cards will go home Tuesday, November 17<sup>th</sup>.

**4. Lost and Found Is Leaving the Building** – Once again, our lost and found items have exceeded the bins we have to store those items. If your child has lost a jacket, lunch box or any other article of clothing, please check with the office. We have several bags of lost items that will be donated if they are not claimed. Thank you for your help.

**5. Please Keep Your Child’s Lunch Account Up to Date** – We have an overwhelming number of overdue lunch accounts this year. Parents can go to [psdschools.org](http://psdschools.org) and click on the Quick Link for Lunch Menus/Payments from there, you can make payments to your school meal account. If you have questions concerning your child’s account, please contact the Tavelli kitchen at 488-6789. Thank you for your help keeping your child’s account current.

**6. Please Keep Your Contact Information Current** – If any of your child’s contact information should change throughout the year, please make a point to stop in at the office or give us a call. We need to have current address, email and phone numbers in case of emergency. The district also relies on this information in the event of a closure due to weather or other circumstances. Thank you for keeping us up-to-date!

**7. Fourth Graders Need Your Help!** – All 4<sup>th</sup> grade classes will be working on a science project and they need 360 2-liter soda bottles to make it happen. If you have any of the large 2-liter bottles at home, please rinse them out and send them, with their caps, to the Tavelli office. Thanks for helping our 4<sup>th</sup> graders with their science project!

**9. Reminders From The Parking Lot** – In order to keep cars flowing in the morning, please continue all the way around the circle to the back building entrance near the kindergarten rooms to drop off your child. Cars are backed up into the street in the morning, creating an unsafe situation. If you want to assist your child in exiting your

vehicle and entering the building, please park in the back lot so we can keep traffic moving smoothly and children safe in the parking lot.

**10. Educational Rights** – As a parent or legal guardian of any PSD student, educational rights must be granted in order to access student information online or to receive emergency/inclement weather notifications from PSD through email. The student data forms sent home at the beginning of the year included a check box for educational rights. If you did not check the box, you will not be able to access any information on ParentVUE. Please contact the school office in writing to grant educational rights for each of your students.

**11. Safety First!** -- For the safety of our children we ask that you enter the building at the main entrance--this applies to everyone, even if you are wearing your badge. Our sign-in system can give us an exact picture of who is in our building, so in the event of an emergency we know who is on our campus. Please stop by the office, sign in and get a visitor's badge if you don't have a permanent volunteer badge. Teachers will be checking for badges and asking you to return to the office to sign in and put on a badge. Again this is for the protection of our children so we know who is in our building. We also ask that parents drop students off in our back traffic circle to the east of our building. Additionally, in the past, we have had some vehicles make U-Turns in our back traffic circle or drop students off in the middle of Miramont Street. This is very dangerous, especially when we have buses trying to drop off or pick up students. Thank you for your cooperation and keeping all of our students safe.

**12. A Few Reminders for Parents** – a) **If your child is absent from school, please call our attendance line at 488-6726 to let us know your child will be out of school for the day. The office needs daily notification of any absence.** In case of extended absences, please let us know when your child will return. b) If your child will be changing after school dismissal plans, please be sure to send a note explaining the change. c) If you need to pick up your child early, please be sure to stop at the office to sign your child out. d) Students should not arrive at school before 8:35 a.m. The first bell rings at 8:50 a.m. Thank you.

**13. Box Tops For Education and Morning Fresh Milk Caps** – Please bring any General Mills box tops or Morning Fresh milk caps in to the office. Tavelli collects 10 cents for every box top and 5 cents for each milk cap turned in. Please clip neatly around the box tops and make sure your milk caps are clean.
