7. PSD Child Nutrition Providing Free Lunch This Summer – Free lunch is being offered this summer for all children 18 and under from May 30th to August 5th. Children do not need to be part of the Free and Reduced Program or enrolled at PSD. The federally funded program is open to all children 18 and under. Adults can enjoy the same lunch for \$3.25. Each lunch includes an entrée, milk, and eight different fresh fruits and veggies to choose from. Locations for lunch service are:

8. Please Return Your Library Books –If you still have library books at home, please return them. The library loses about 100 books a year due to students not returning them. Thanks for your help keeping our library full of good books!

9. Does Your Student Have Medication in Our Health Office? – If so, please make plans to pick up your student's medication on or before the last day of school. Medications cannot be sent home with students at the end of the school year. The last day of school is Friday, May 29th and dismissal is at noon. Any medications left in the Health Room after that time will be delivered to the DEA for proper disposal. Thank you for your help in this matter!

10. Change In Immunization Exemptions – Beginning July 2016, the process for requesting immunization exemptions will change. Schools will no longer accept paper copies of signed exemptions. 11. Box Tops For Education and Morning Fresh Milk Caps – Please bring any General Mills box tops or Morning Fresh milk caps in to the office.
